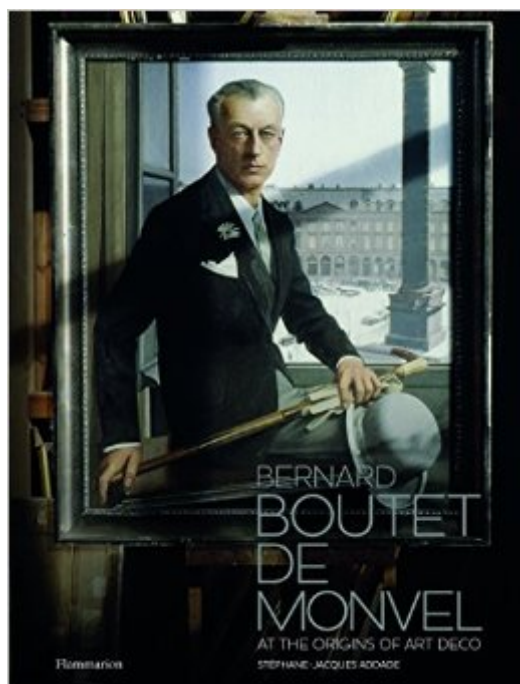

This monograph—the first to be published in English—sheds new light on the artist's protean work and restores his place at the forefront of the history of French and American art.

I have long admired the work of this artist. In the spring of 2016 Sotheby's auctioned off the contents of his Paris home and studio and sparked a new interest in his work. The book is large, 14 x 11, and the photographs are bright and crisp. The book starts with his early life and origins and focuses on some of the work of his artist father (also an unsung master). Then it details his start, life in Paris and the US, painting Norman Rockwell-like detailed portraits of the rich and famous of the day. You will not regret this purchase.
